By collaborating as a **diverse** group of leaders representing local nonprofit arts organizations, ensuring our initiatives reflect the voices and values of our community.


Steering Committee Details

- Volunteer Role
- Meeting Frequency: Monthly (90 minutes)
- Committee Size: Maximum 12 members (Currently there are 6 members)
- Quorum Requirement: ²/₃ attendance for decision-making
- Appointment term: 12 months for new Steering Committee members.

Steering Committee Applicant Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- Be the designated representative for a nonprofit arts organization or entity producing, presenting, or promoting the arts (visual, performing, literary, etc.).
- Be based within the <u>Downtown San Rafael Precise Plan area</u> (or within a 5 minute walk of the Plan boundary
- Commit to attending monthly meetings and participating in at least one subcommittee.
- Support DSRAD's mission to unite and uplift the arts community in San Rafael.
- Adhere to the Steering Committee Bylaws and agree to our Code of Conduct



New steering committee members will be considered based on the applicant organization's alignment with the DSRAD mission and representation of diverse artistic disciplines, as well as the applicant's personal professional background and skills that respond to current committee needs.

Application Process & Timeline*

- Applications Open: August 1, 2025
- Application Deadline (for first review cycle): August 29, 2025
- Interview applicants as schedules allow in early September, 2025
- Application Review: Week of September 18, 2025 Steering Committee Meeting.
- Notification of Status: Applicants will be contacted via email by two weeks after meetings at which a vote is taken.
- Ongoing Applications: After September 2025, applications will be reviewed and approved on a rolling basis at regular Steering Committee meetings, as needed.
